NATIONAL EXAMS

Canisius achieved a remarkable 99.4% and 100% pass rate in the Grade 9 and 12 national examinations, respectively. We encourage parents to take an active interest in their child's academic performance. Please review their notebooks and provide feedback where necessary.

ELECTRICAL SAFETY

Unfortunately, some pupils have been tampering with electrical wiring in the hostels to charge their phones. Please caution your child about the potential dangers of this behavior, which could lead to fires or electrocution. Vandalism must be stopped at all costs. Chargeable gadgets and electric kettles are prohibited, and any student caught with such items will be fined ZMW 1,000 per gadget.

OTHER KEY ISSUES

COLLECTION OF MATTRESSES:

Mattresses will be distributed by the house masters between 08:00-09:00hrs, 14:00-15:00hrs, and 17:00-18:00hrs.

END OF TERM RESULTS:

The results for the end of term one will be sent on Friday, April 21st, 2023.

TERM 2 RE-OPENING:

The school will **reopen on Monday, May 8th, 2023**, and all boarders must arrive on Sunday, May 7th, 2023. **Lessons will commence at 7:15am on Monday**, and pupils who report late will be given heavy manual labor as punishment.

School REQUIREMENTS

Students must report to school with the following items:

1. Limited to **three** of each: shirts, t-shirts, trousers, shorts.
2. Mosquito net and, if possible, repellents.
3. One bucket, cup, plate, spoon, and a container for drinking water (sharing is not allowed).
4. Sufficient lotion, toothpaste, washing powder, bathing soap, and polish for one term.
5. **Pocket money of ZMW 600**, to be deposited in the school account with school fees.
6. **Foodstuffs are NOT Allowed.**
7. A minimum of three washable masks.
8. Two complete sets of school uniform are required, consisting of a white shirt, a tie with the school logo, grey trousers, grey socks, a grey jersey, a grey head sock, a black belt, and Bata Toughes shoes. All personal belongings must fit into the school lockers provided, except for a bucket
